VBS Checklist

Here are some things to consider as you prepare for VBS:

- Promotion. Feel free to refer parents to vbscharleston.com for a VBS overview. We have also set up a Facebook page of the same name that you can link to. In addition, banners, emails, postcards, videos, websites, and newsletters were used to get the word out. Feel free to use the VBS South Carolina logo and Facebook cover to personalize your promotional materials.
- Registration. Registration is essential for good follow-up! Registration also helps determine how many bags of materials to prepare. You may use any method you like for registration.
- Materials. You may choose to offer more or fewer materials in VBS bags.
 You may also choose to provide materials in digital format only.
- Materials distribution. How will you distribute materials to your families?
 Pick-up? Home delivery?
- Missions project. The missions segment will reference our city-wide missions project, a food drive to replenish our food banks in response to the increased need of our community for food resources.
- Pathways for communication. How will parents communicate with you if they have questions? Feel free to use the communication resource from the vbscharleston.com page beginning July 13, if you would prefer. If you choose this option, please contact us via the Charleston VBS Facebook page or email so that we can connect parents in your community with you.
- Follow-up. How will you reach out to families who participated in VBS to continue Gospel conversations?
